## PROPERTY HISTORY

The Dan'l Webster Inn and Spa is a 48 room inn located in the Cape's oldest town, Sandwich. Sandwich comprises some 44 square miles and was settled in 1637 by settlers led by Edward Freeman from Plymouth Colony, across Cape Cod Bay. On what is today the Inn's property, once sat a parsonage, built in 1692 by Minister Roland Cotton. During the 1750's the parsonage became the Fessenden Tavern, one of the first and most famous of New England's taverns and a Patriot headquarters during the American Revolution. Sadly, a fire destroyed the original building in 1971; it was rebuilt shortly thereafter. In 1980, the property was purchased by the Catania family, who also own and operate the Cape Codder Resort & Spa (Hyannis), John Carver Inn & Spa (Plymouth) and six Hearth 'n Kettle restaurants throughout Cape Cod and southeastern Massachusetts.

## AREA HISTORY

The Town of Sandwich is a seaside community of about 23,000 residents located in the northeast corner of Cape Cod in Barnstable County, Massachusetts. Incorporated in 1639, Sandwich is the oldest town on Cape Cod and one of the oldest towns in the United States, settled by European immigrants nearly 150 years before the American Revolution.

Located on both sides of the Cape Cod Canal, the majority of its population and land mass is on the southerly side of the canal. Sandwich is a mostly residential community with a year round population considerably smaller than during the warm summer. The town's charm and uniqueness, combined with its ideal location, makes Sandwich an attractive place to both visit and live. Sandwich's beaches along Cape Cod Bay stretch for miles and provide wonderful ocean vistas and views of many vessels passing through on their way to and from the Boston area. Commercial fishermen and lobstermen can be seen unloading their catches at the docks of the Sandwich Marina, the only harbor along the Canal.
